CALL TO ORDER

A quorum being established, Mayor Newbury called the meeting to order.

AT ROLL CALL, the following members were present: Mr. Holland, Ms. Jones, and Ms. Linder. Mr. Newbury was not present.

Ms. Linder moved, and it was seconded by Mr. Holland, to ACCEPT THE MINUTES of the previous meeting (May 11, 2021). The roll call vote was unanimous. The motion passed.

OLD BUSINESS

The general opinion and reflections on the Breamfest were that it was a huge success. The weather was the best anyone can remember for this festival. Excellent turn out and lots of really good fun and food.

Mayor Newbury told the council that potential financing to fix the tramroad is being discussed with the PDD. So far it looks as if the money would be available at a 75/25 match. The county Judge has offered labor as soft match, so we will have to wait and see about how this works out.

In the meantime, the town is hoping to receive some ARPA funds in the future as well.

The mayor stated that the resolution to add the new pumps and delete the old ones from the Fixed Assets Inventory will be voted on next month.

When the mayor reported back to the council as instructed about the Service Line Warranty program, she informed the Council that the program has an educational and a warranty aspect. Educating the public on what their responsibilities are with regard to city services and equipment and a warranty program for their responsibility. The Mayor agreed to send each council member a copy of the information she received from her contact.

NEW BUSINESS

FINANCIALS

Ms. Jones moved, and it was seconded by Ms. Linder, to approve the corrected April Sewer Fund report. The Mayor explained that a large Fixed Asset Purchase had been erroneously added to the Maintenance and Repair line in the budget report. This has been corrected. The motion passed unanimously on an oral vote.

Ms. Jones moved, and it was seconded by Mr. Holland, to adjourn the meeting. The oral vote was unanimous. The motion passed.
