

**Minutes
Felsenthal City Council
Meeting
March 10, 2015**

A quorum being established, Mayor Newbury called the meeting to order. At roll call the following members were present: Mr. Holland, Mr. Clawson, Mr. Newbury, and Mrs. Harris. Ms. Neal was not present.

Mr. Clawson moved, seconded by Mr. Newbury, to accept the minutes for the regular meeting, February 10, 2015. The roll call vote was unanimous. The motion passed.

Old Business

The Mayor reported that there was no new information on the Grant from Arkansas Street Aid Commission.

Other announcements included the following: 1) We are continuing to send monthly progress reports to ADEQ. 2) We have called Entergy about getting electricity run to our #2 sewer pond. Payment was received for the damage to our water lines by a logging operation. 3) Mr. Hickman, from the Sheriff's office, will be coming down to continue our training for our Neighborhood Watch. Also, we have a citizen Mr. Joe Hart that has also volunteered to help with the training. A time will be set up in the near future. 4) We are awaiting response from Verizon about getting a booster on our water tower for better service.

The problem of dogs running loose or being mistreated was discussed. Mr. Charles Hartsell was called in to pick-up some puppies that were running loose and sick and to have some dogs relocated that were not being properly cared for in the cold and wet weather.

New Business

The council voted to make adjustments to fixed assets inventory: delete one old computer and add a new one. Mrs. Harris moved to adjust the fixed assets accordingly, and her motion was seconded by Mr. Holland. At roll call the vote was unanimous. The motion passed.

The Arkansas Municipal League sent a letter, which we are researching, which could lead to a new ordinance. The communication from the AML stated that we needed to designate someone to collect fines for the town when the District Court assesses them. This is usually the District Court Clerk. When we research this further, we will share the information with the council and the public.

February, 2015 financial reports were presented and discussed. Mr. Clawson moved, and was seconded by Mr. Holland, to accept the financial reports as presented. At roll call the vote was unanimous. The motion passed.

Mrs. Harris moved to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Mr. Newbury. Roll call vote was unanimous. The motion passed.
